How will you respond to harmful language and build acceptance in your classroom?





Harvest of the Month



BELL PEPPER OVEN FRIES

yield: 6 SERVINGS

prep time: 10 MINUTES

total time: 35 MINUTES

recipe from delish.com

INGREDIENTS

2 bell peppers, sliced into 1/2" rounds, seeds removed

2 large eggs, beaten with 1 tbsp water

1 c. flour

1 1/2 c. panko breadcrumbs

1 tsp. paprika

1 tsp. garlic powder

1 tsp. kosher salt

FOR DIPPING SAUCE

1/3 c. mayonnaise

1/3 c. sour cream

2 tbsp. ketchup

1 tbsp. finely chopped parsley

1 tsp. Worcestershire sauce

kosher salt

Freshly ground black pepper

INSTRUCTIONS

- Preheat oven to 400° and line a large baking sheet with parchment paper. In a medium shallow bowl, combine panko with paprika, garlic powder, and salt. Coat pepper rings first in flour, then egg, then panko mixture. Place on prepared baking sheet.
- 2. Bake 10 minutes, flip peppers and bake 10 minutes more, until tender. Remove from oven and let cool slightly.
- 3. While peppers are baking, make dipping sauce: In a medium bowl, combine mayonnaise, sour cream, ketchup, parsley and Worcestershire sauce. Season with salt and pepper and whisk to combine.
- 4. Serve pepper rings with dipping sauce on the side.
